## INVERARY CREEK LANDCARE GROUP

Field day on dry land salinity at Minalinka. 5.2.95

The problems of dry land salinity were well demonstrated to the 32 people who attended a very important field day. Guest speaker for the day was Gavin Pryde, Field Officer from C.A.L.M., who explained the rehabilitation of the upper reaches of Inverary Creek. This will involve the construction of two large dams, diversion works, flumes and extensive tree planting. Work is already well underway with the earthworks by C.A.L.M. who has fully co-operated with the Landcare Group on the SALT ACTION PROJECT and brought it into the SHOALHAVEN SCHEME.

Mr John Fahey extended his apologies and was represented by Secretary Chris Neale.

Landcare President, Kevin Cooper, explained how this project was an essential part of the full restoration of Inverary Creek and Limekiln Creek and linked up with 1994 works by C.A.L.M. and W.R.C. on Wilduk.

NEWS ON FUNDING: Two future projects on Limekiln Creek applied for in 1994 have now been approved and will be explained at future field days. These will involve work on the Winston Gully and Limekiln Creek to Inverary Road. Further applications have been made to extend the restoration of Inverary Creek in Guy Burketts to Creek Junction and more salinity work on Wilduk.

NEXT FIELD DAY AND MEETING. As a trial, requested by some members, this will be held on a Saturday not Sunday. SATURDAY MAY 27th (4th Saturday) at 1.00pm. We shall meet at "Inverary", where transport will be organised, to inspect the field trials on Cowhole Creek Paddock (our 1994 SALT ACTION PROJECT) and then on to Joe Letherbarrows for more field work.

The pasture trials are now showing quite interesting results. You can also see success of tree planting with the Youman Planter despite adverse seasons.

Make it a date - these field days are open to all the public, not only Landcare members.

NEW LANDCARE GROUPS. With the huge success of the Inverary Creek Landcare it is obvious that more, similarly structured groups, could be very successful in the area. Only a small number of members are needed to form a group. Maybe a village and surrounds group. Upper Bungonia Creek or Lower Bungonia Creek etc could be organised. Anyone interested should contact the Landcare Specialist Alice Gardner at C.A.L.M., or myself, for information.



## GARDENING IN APRIL



Plant seedlings such as alyssum, canterbury bells, carnations, cornflowers, delphiniums, dianthus, hollyhocks, russel lupins, pansies, violas, primula, snapdragons, stocks, sweet peas and wallflowers.

In your vege garden: Plant **broad beans, peas, cabbages and onions**. Broad beans like cooler weather and they will be ready for picking in late winter or early spring. Remember to lime the soil before planting.

#### Tuna Mornay

60gms butter

1½ cups milk

1 cup peas

¾ cup water

1 tsp french mustard

2 tbsp plain flour

425g tuna

Chicken stock

2 cups cooked pasta

½ cup grated cheese

Heat butter in pan. Add flour. Stir over heat for 1 min. Gradually add milk. Combine stock, water and mustard and stir into mixture until it boils and thickens. Remove from heat. Add tuna, cheese, peas and pasta. Stir over heat until hot.
