Woodwards Creek: The Woodward's Creek fence has been erected. This is an erosion control measure recommended to help stabilize badly eroded creeks and to prevent the dumping of rubbish.

Rivercare Plan: This is being developed under instruction and guidance from Brad Davies of the Sydney Water Catchment Authority. The Trustees were required to describe the geomorphology, geology, fauna, flora, flood characteristics, land use history and to provide old photos etc. The plan should be finalized this month.

Playground: The Trust has been granted a small amount to put in another piece of play equipment.

Trustees: One of our Trustees has moved out of the district and another resigned because of home and work commitments. The Trustees would like to invite anyone interested in the Park to come to our next meeting. The Park which stretches from Mrs Durack's boundary to Woodward's Creek has been part of the village since it was surveyed in 1832. The Minister for Land and Water Conservation appoints Trustees and all legal activities are covered by public liability insurance held by the Dept. of Land and Water Conservation.

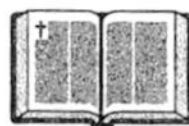
NEXT COMMUNION SERVICE: Sunday 11th August, 2002 at 5pm
